

Eastern border by the accord with Stalin, invaded Poland. Britain, treaty-bound to defend Poland, declared war on Germany two days later. Baum and several thousand others were interned as dangerous enemy aliens. CommuNazis in the parlance of the day.

While Hitler and Stalin proceeded to divide up Europe, the internees were not idle. Comrade Hans Kahle, former Colonel Chief of the 11th International (Communist) Brigade in the Spanish Civil War, set up a Communist cell (school) in the camp. His best students were Comrade Baum and Comrade Klaus Fuchs.

In 1940 Hitler's bombs fell on London, and invasion was considered imminent so the internees were transferred to Canada. Comrades Kahle, Fuchs and Baum were interned in the Sherbrooke Camp and the Communist cell was soon back in operation.

(Catholic publications in Canada always summarize the above information by saying "Baum came from England to Canada in 1940".)

At this time Canadian Reds were doing their utmost to impede recruiting and sabotage the "imperialist war" against Hitler. Red leaders were in internment camps along with Nazis, or in hiding. The "imperialist war" became a "holy war against fascism" on July 22, 1941, for it was on this date that Hitler turned on his Soviet ally, ending one of the few treaties the Communists ever lived up to. Communist propaganda did a quick about-face, and Communists became super-patriots overnight.

THE COMRADES ARE "LIBERATED"

The Soviet Union ordered Canadian Reds to concentrate on "liberating" their interned comrades. Comrade Kahle's cell was placed under Canadian NKVD boss Norman Freed, who was in direct contact with the new Soviet Embassy in Ottawa. Communists were put in charge of censoring internees' mail and catering at the camp.

A German Dominican priest (who was a secret Red) visited the internees and "converted" Baum to Protestantism. This ecumenical gesture greatly facilitated his liberation.

The foregoing information is from the files of Mr. Patrick Walsh, former RCMP undercover agent 208A. Baum's presence in Sherbrooke Camp is confirmed in Macleans Magazine, February 10, 1962. Comrade Kahle ended up as East German Secret Police boss after W.W. II.

Comrade Fuchs was sent to University in England and trained to be an atomic scientist. He

worked at Harwell and at Los Alamos where he learned all the secrets of the Atomic Bomb, which he turned over to the Rosenberg-Greenglass-Gold spy network for transmission to Russia. For this he served 14 years in British prisons. On release he disappeared behind the Iron Curtain where he holds a top spot in Russian Atomic Research.

The Rosenbergs were executed amid frantic screams from Communists and leftists the world over. A Communist campaign to have the Rosenbergs "cleared" is now under way, even though their own relatives testified as to their guilt, and the first Russian Atomic Bomb was almost a carbon copy of the Hiroshima bomb.

BAUM'S SECOND CONVERSION

Baum was released in 1942 under the sponsorship of a good Protestant lady and enrolled at Baptist McMaster University where he graduated with a B.A. He went on to Ohio State and was converted a second time, to Roman Catholicism. He took the name of Gregory in Baptism.

He then joined the Augustinians (Luther's Order) who sent him to seminary in Switzerland. He was ordained and came back to Toronto with a Dr. Th. degree to teach sons of the rich and the priests of the church. Soon he became a "consultant" to the Vatican on Christian Unity and a collaborator with the controversial Cardinal Bea. These honors are seldom mentioned now, since radical theologians are somewhat unpopular at the Vatican.

He soon became a popular writer and lecturer, private theologian to Archbishop Pocock, and editor of The Ecumenist, a small but influential periodical devoted to changing Catholicism. From Communist internee to "leading Catholic Theologian" in only 17 years takes a bit of doing. The following facts emerge.

(1) Baum grew up, a Communist in Nazi Berlin, in an atmosphere of intrigue and conspiracy.

(2) He has never suffered the hardships of Iron Curtain existence.

(3) He spent 4 formative years in Communist youth organizations, three with expert teacher Hans Kahle.

(4) True converts from Communism openly admit their past and repudiate its ideology. Baum never has.

(5) True converts from Communism are attacked by the Party apparatus. Baum never was.

BAUM AND THE ECUMENICAL SWINDLE

At the Vatican Council in 1964, Baum teamed up with fellow converts Bea, Osterreicher, Kerpe,
