

Slansky and Arceo to force certain concessions to the Jews from Pope John XXIII. This provoked sharp disagreement among the delegates. (See "How the Jews Changed Catholic Thinking" Look, January 25, 1966.)

Fr. Baum makes a big thing of attacking every trace of anti-semitism even though (according to some Rabbis) he knows little about Judaism.

After courteous treatment by the United Church Observer, Baum attacked its editor, Rev. A.C. Forrest, for publishing "How the Zionists Control Your News." Yet Fr. Baum has never criticized the Soviets for their treatment of the Jews.

DIALOGUE between Catholics and Communists was an invention of European Communists. It was introduced to America when Fr. Baum and his friends brought French Communist Roger Garaudy to address the students at St. Michael's College. From Toronto, Garaudy travelled all over America. The most important feature of the "dialogue" was that the Communists did all the talking and the Catholics did all the listening.

BIRTH CONTROL was an IDO-C manufactured issue enthusiastically promoted by Gregory Baum. As a Pill salesman he stumped the U.S. and Canada. He managed to con most Canadian and some American Bishops into thinking that Pope Paul would approve the Pill. When it was banned instead Baum filled the secular press with advice to ignore *Humanae Vitae*. Sad to say, the Pill was neither reliable nor a prophylactic. Teenage pregnancies and VD followed in epidemic proportions.

GREGORY BAUM AND IDO-C SUBVERSION

IDO-C activists, condemned for their "corrosive criticism" by Pope Paul, are an international mutual admiration society of anti-Papal writers and publishers. They review, praise, promote and publish one another's attacks on orthodox Catholicism. The IDO-C Establishment has a virtual monopoly in the dissemination of information about Catholicism, including books and catechisms.

Fr. Baum heads Canadian IDO-C personnel; others are Leslie Dewart (St. Mike's), Gerard Lemieux (CBC), M. Chabot, Bernard Daly and M. Brennan.

U.S. activists include John Cogley, Msgr. Hanley, Gary McEoin, Fr. Sheerin and Msgr. Yzermans, under whose editorship Our Sunday Visitor almost folded.

IDO-C has promoted such disruptive campaigns

as Birth Control, the revolt against priestly celibacy, the ordination of women and downgrading of the Papacy. It is now promoting the Theology of Revolution and Catholic Membership in the World Council of Churches. Sex Education is also being promoted and has split Catholic School supporters in Ottawa.

GREGORY BAUM AND THE CATHOLIC LEFT

Along with being an IDO-C activist, Fr. Baum is associated with the Catholic (?) Left of New York City. He and Leslie Dewart hold a number of posts in front groups like CALCAV, Emmaus House, Catholic Peace Fellowship and "Saint" Dorothy Day's Catholic-Communist American Pax, a near relative of International Pax and Polish Pax, arm of the Polish Secret Police.

People active in these fronts have included ex-sister Corita (pop artist), ex-priests Phil Berrigan (et frau), Kavanaugh, Clarence E. Duffy, Meyer and Dubay as well as motley oddballs from even odder sects. Fr. Dubay attacked Card. McIntyre as a "racist", tried to organize a Priests Union, tried marriage with a divorcee, and left that for homosexuality.

Fr. Baum is not the only Catholic-leftist in Canada, only the most notorious. Dr. Leslie Dewart, also a theologian at St. Mike's, is a pro-Castro Cuban and founder of the Toronto Fair Play for Cuba Committee. President Kennedy's assassin was a Fair Play for Cuba organizer.

Fr. Arthur Gibson, Chairman of Religious Studies at St. Mike's, also dabbles in politics as a fan of Chairman Mao. He had high praise for the Red Guards until they got so unruly that Mao had some of them shot. Fr. Gibson even wrote an article praising them in the *World Marxist Review*. It was reprinted in the *Maoist Progressive Worker*.

Rev. Leo Lafreniere is now muscling in on the headline-grabbing. A virile looking, pipe-smoking 60, with a Doctorate from Louvain, Lafreniere is the Sex-Ed. Czar of Catholic schools in Ontario.

Attached to Bishop Alex Carter's diocese, he trains Catholic teachers to teach the *Becoming A Person* program. BAP seems to be about the same "Sex is For Fun" program as that promoted by the atheistic SIECUS group. In his spare time Fr. Lafreniere shocks the pants off orthodox lay people, Protestant and Catholic, with his T.V. and press interviews. In one of these he refused to call masturbation, fornication or homosexuality sinful.
